GRADUATE GOES TO CAYMAN FOR TRAINING

International Banking Group's Graduate Leadership trainee has begun the first phase of training in Cayman following a few weeks of introduction at the Bank's headquarters in Providenciales.

Mr Jamie Wilson was offered the position following intense competition and a rigorous interview process last June. He officially began his career in January this year after completing his studies in Business Administration at Brock University in Canada with honours. In February he made the trip to Cayman where he will be undergoing intensive training in all areas of bank activity, returning for a year of specialisation.

The pioneering programme, first launched in February last year, offers a unique fast-track career to management through an intensive training programme exposing the trainee to all retail and commercial banking departments. The first phase of the programme consists in 12 months training in Cayman across all business areas and central group functions, this is followed by another two years split between Cayman and TCI during which time he will pursue a specialisation.



Speaking from Cayman, Jamie said of the programme and the move:

"Moving to Cayman for the first real phase of the programme is really exciting for me as I have been looking forward to it since I first found out about the opportunity offered by International Banking Group. While I will miss the Turks & Caicos, working in Cayman is great – it offers an environment that is similar to TCI but is bigger and more established so it's a great opportunity to learn."
