TCI's newest retail bank appoints President and Chief Executive

International Banking Group (TCI) Ltd, the Turks and Caicos newest retail banking proposition has appointed Ivan Browne as its President and Chief Executive.



Mr. Browne brings to the bank a wealth of experience of retail and commercial banking gained over more than three decades in 16 countries across the Caribbean and Africa.

For 28 years Mr. Browne worked at Barclays Bank in areas as diverse as credit risk management, process re-engineering and marketing. For a further 4 years he worked at FirstCaribbean, at first leading the Caribbean team involved in the integration of Barclays and CIBC's Caribbean operations and later as Corporate Banking Director for the OECS (Organization of Eastern Caribbean States). More recently he set up Caribbean Union Bank in Antigua – the first new bank in the OECS for 15 years and then in September 2006 he was appointed Chairman of Bank of Nevis.

He brings to the Turks and Caicos his relentless ambition for the region to meet and exceed world standards of service in banking.

His contribution to the regional financial services sector is reflected in his being one of only 8 persons awarded the Inaugural Lifetime Honorary Fellowship in the Caribbean Association of Banking and Financial Institutes (FCABFI). Other recipients included Dr Marion Williams, Governor of the Central Bank of Barbados and Mr Timothy Donaldson, the first Governor of the Central Bank of the Bahamas.

The Governor of the Eastern Caribbean Central Bank recognised Mr Browne for "Distinguished Service to the Banking Industry in the Eastern Caribbean" and he played a key role in the establishment of the Eastern Caribbean Institute of Banking, serving as one of the founding directors.

His continuing professional education has gained him fellowship in the Chartered Institute of Bankers (UK), the Chartered Management Institute (UK), the Institute of Management

Services (UK), membership in the Institute of Directors (UK) and the Accredited Director Designation from ICSA Canada.

On taking up his new role at International Banking Group, Mr Browne said:

“When the opportunity arose to establish a bank in the growing and prosperous Turks and Caicos Islands, it was a chance I could not turn down. I am looking forward to building International Banking Group (TCI) as a leading internationally accepted financial services institution offering world class products and services that provides a rewarding workplace for our employees, career opportunities for Turks and Caicos Islanders, and enhances the well being of our community. I am also excited to make Turks and Caicos our new home.”

Active also in the community, Mr Browne has held a number of positions in Rotary Clubs across the region, including Assistant Governor for Antigua and President in St Vincent.

Mr Browne, a native of Montserrat, is married with two children and one grandson. He enjoys photography and golf and was the Inaugural Secretary/Treasurer of the Antigua/Barbuda Golf Association and served the OECS Golf Association in a similar capacity.

Mr. Browne’s community involvement has also seen him take an active role in private sector organisations including the roles of President, Vice-President and Director of Chambers of Industry & Commerce in Grenada, St Vincent and Montserrat respectively.
